

Documents Required for “Medical Treatment”

1. Application form filled completely and signed specifying Place and date of signature. Color Photo affixed on prescribed location with three addition photos. In case of minors both parents or legal guardian have to sign the form.
2. Only Sindh & Balochistan residents are eligible to apply for visa application, in other cases proof of residence for at least six months in these two provinces must be provided
3. Motivational Letter from the applicant addressed to the Visa Officer explaining the purpose of visit.
4. Travelers Accident & Hospitalization (Sickness) Policy.
5. Airline ticket with confirmed return date.
6. Hotel reservation confirmed or letter of invitation by an Italian resident.
7. Medical documentation including: a) medical documentation issued in the country of residence confirming the illness; b) declaration from an Italian public or private healthcare facility (the latter must be accredited by the National Health Service) indicating the type of treatment, start date, duration, and estimated cost; c) confirmation from the Italian healthcare facility of a deposit of at least 30% of the estimated cost of the requested treatment, or, alternatively, a specific regional resolution or authorization issued by the Ministry of Health under humanitarian programs
8. Medical certificate confirming the need for specific treatment in Italy
9. Proof of sufficient resources in Italy to cover the remaining healthcare costs, accommodation, and repatriation of the patient and any accompanying person

10. For accompanying persons, health insurance with a minimum coverage of €30,000 for urgent hospital treatment and repatriation costs
11. Round-trip booking or ticket, or proof of availability of personal means of transport, including for any accompanying person
12. Family Registration Certificate (F.R.C) and Marriage Registration Certificate (M.R.C).
13. Photocopies of last three passports. (First two pages copy and all the visas & stamp copies)
