Medical Treatment Visa

- Visa application form
- Recent passport-sized photograph
- Valid travel document with an expiry date at least three months beyond the requested visa's expiry
- Medical documentation including:
 - a) Medical documentation issued in the country of residence confirming the actual illness
 - b) Declaration from the Italian public or private healthcare facility (the latter must be accredited with the National Health Service) indicating the type of treatment, start date, duration, and estimated cost
 - c) Certification from the Italian healthcare facility confirming the deposit of at least 30% of the estimated cost of the requested service, or alternatively, a specific regional resolution or specific authorization issued by the Ministry of Health under humanitarian programs
- Documentation proving sufficient resources in Italy to cover the remaining medical expenses, food, accommodation outside the healthcare facility, and repatriation of the patient and any accompanying person
- For any accompanying persons, health insurance with a minimum coverage of €30,000, covering emergency hospitalization costs and repatriation expenses
- Round-trip reservation or ticket, or proof of availability of personal transportation means, including for any accompanying person
