## **MEDICAL TREATMENT VISA REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- 1) Visa application form duly filled by the applicant. Complete residential and official (if applicable) address, telephone numbers, name of parents must be written in the form. In case of minor(s), the form should be signed by both parents. The visa application form can be downloaded from the website <a href="www.ambislamabad.esteri.it">www.ambislamabad.esteri.it</a> or <a href="https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home.aspx">https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home.aspx</a>
- 2) Two color passport-size photographs no older than 6 months, in white background and unedited. One photograph must be glued on the visa application and the second one, bearing on the reverse side the applicant's full name, should be attached to the application form with a paper clip
- 3) An ordinary passport valid at least three months from the expiry date of the visa applied for. This document must have at least two empty pages. All previous passport(s), if any, are to be attached. In case of lost passport(s), the Police Report must be attached in original to the form.
- 4) Medical record/documentation of the patient/applicant, comprising of:
  - Medical documents (certificates) issued in the Country of Residence, attesting the illness
    of the patient/applicants. Medical Certificate should be attested by the MoFA.
  - Declaration by a public of private Italian Healthcare Facility, indicating type of treatment, starting date, estimated duration and costs. The Healthcare Facility must be accredited with the National Health Service of Italy.
  - Document from the Italian Healthcare Facility, confirming the deposit of at least 30% of the estimated costs of the treatment requested. As an alternative, a specific administrative act by an Italian Region of a specific authorization issued by the Ministry of Health, in the framework of an humanitarian program.
- 5) Evidence of availability, in Italy, of financial resources covering the whole period of stay, the cost of the remaining Healthcare expenses, lodging and food outside the Healthcare Facility, repatriation of the patient and companion(s) if any
- 6) Travel Insurance(s), for patient and companion(s) if any, for at least 30.000 euros. The insurance must cover medical and hospital expenses, for the entire period of stay in Schengen territory, as well as repatriation costs.
- 7) Proof of accommodation in Italy for the whole duration of treatment/stay
- 8) Copy of flight(s) bookings

- 9) Copy of Family Registration Certificate issued by NADRA, only if a family member is accompanying the main applicant.
- 10) Underage applicant(s) travelling with a single parent must bear a written consent of the other parent, with copy of his/her FRC.
- 11) Applicant from a Third Country residing in Pakistan must provide supporting documents attesting their legal residence in Pakistan.
- 12) If the applicant has been denied a Visa by an Embassy/High Commission in the last two years, written relation concerning the reason of travel and refusal (copy of refusal letter could be attached to the form)

- Admissibility of applications will be treated as per Visa Code (EU Regulation (CE) n.810/2009).
- It is highly recommended for timely processing of the application that the same be complete of all the above requested documents.
- The Embassy reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documents
- Any forged/fake documents will be reported to the relevant Authorities
